

on 21st of February, 2012 at New Delhi**



Minutes of the Annual General Body Meeting of All India Agricultural Students Association (AIASA) held on 21st of February, 2012 at New Delhi

The Annual General Body Meeting of AIASA (AGM-Extraordinary) was held on 21.2.2012 at 4:30 PM at IARI campus, New Delhi under the chairmanship of Shri Sandeep Kumar, National President, AIASA. Since this was the first AGM after the registration of AIASA, the quorum could not be met, therefore, meeting was adjourned for half an hour and reassemble at 5PM. The list of participants is annexed.

The National President welcomed the members and associate members for taking keen interest for carrying out the activities of AIASA for welfare of agriculturists/agriculture in the country. The following issues were discussed and decision taken:

- I. Budget & Account matters:** The treasurer of AIASA presented the details of expenditure incurred/likely to be incurred and sought approval for the budget for the year 2012. The details are given as under:

The Treasurer informed that at least 2-3 Executive Committee meeting will be held during 2012 for which about Rs.20,000/- expenses will be made during 2012. Besides, the Core Group members may like to move to different SAUs/colleges for awareness campaign for joining membership by each and every student. The total Expenses for TA& DA (if applicable) will be around Rs.50,000/- during 2012. The General Body approved the proposal moved by treasurer. Shri Biswajit Mondal moved the proposal that if member called for meetings at HQ or travel to outstation they may be allowed the DA upto the maximum limit of Rs.500 to meet the expenses for stay and food if so arranged by them. The General body has approved the expenses incurred by Executive and budget for the year 2012 and further authorized the Executives/Governing Body to take appropriate decisions to collect the money through donation/membership fee to meet out the expenses of forthcoming activities. Dr. D. N. Singh, former Additional Commissioner & Associate Member has mentioned that National President, Chief Coordinator and General Secretary may be allowed the reimbursement of mobile call expenses upto the maximum limit of Rs.1000/month for time being for taking up membership drive in all the States. This facility could also be given to other core committee members at appropriate time based on the work performance and resources of the association. The General body authorized the National President to take appropriate action in the matter. Besides, the Association has to meet the expenses of about Rs.50,000 towards AIASA website designed by professional agency namely M/s Soleosis. The General body approved the proposal for settlement of payment towards AIASA website.

II. Handing over and taking over charge by Executive Committee: The National President informed the house that AIASA has been registered under societies Registration Act, 1860 vide registration No.S/RS/SW/0522/2011 on 1.12.2011. The Association has applied for Permanent account Number (PAN). Because of late receipt of registration of AIASA, the process for conducting election for electing the Governing Body/Executives for the year 2012 could not be initiated in the previous year and the existing Executive Committee (founder members) continued to function to look after the affairs of


the society. The National President moved the proposal before the house to approve the functioning of existing Executive Committee upto 29th February. The New Executive committee will take over the charge on 1st March, 2012 and would function in accordance with bye-laws of the society. The General body passed the resolution as under:

"Resolves that new Executive committee for the year 2012 will take charge from the Existing executive Committee on 1st March, 2012 and will continue to function till 31st December, 2012 in accordance with bye-laws of the society and further resolves that intimation will be given to SBI, Beej Bhawan alongwith specimen signature of the authorized officer for operating the account. The decision taken by existing Executive committee will be valid upto 29th February, 2012."

III. Membership Drive: It was decided to enroll all the students pursuing their degree/diploma in agriculture and allied sciences (Agriculture, Veterinary, Fishery, Animal Husbandry, Dairy, Horticulture, Agricultural Engineering, Forestry, Agri-Business Management etc.) in the country as members of the Society and agricultural professional as associate members of the society. University coordinator of each Agricultural University/ Deemed University/Central Agricultural University/Autonomous or Recognized Agricultural Colleges/Institutions under the networking of Vice-president and Joint-secretary of their respective zones (East, West, North, South, Central and North East Zones) in coordination with Chief coordinator and Senior Vice President, General Secretary of the association in the national level membership drive. The General body has fixed the target to enroll 100,000 students as members within 6 months.

IV. Election of Executive committee: The national President handed over the stage to the Honorary Policy advisor to conduct the Election of executive committee Members for the year 2012. The Honorary Policy advisor asked nomination for various posts. The House decided to appoint governing Body/Cabinet members unanimously. Accordingly, following names were proposed in the General Body for various posts and the General Body unanimously elected them as Governing Body Members/Cabinet Members and thereafter the newly elected National President also constituted advisory team as under:




The General body has authorized National President to fill up the vacant post of University coordinator(s) in consultation of Chief Coordinator and concerned Vice Chancellor of Agriculture University(s) by second week of April, 2012 on consensus/election basis.

V. Special Associate Membership: To raise fund it was decided to have a "Special Associate Membership" for industries, organization and interested individuals. The Special Associate Membership will be of four types:

- Diamond Associate Membership – Rs. 100,000/- (Rupees One lakh only)
- Platinum Associate Membership – Rs. 75,000/- (Rupees seventy five thousand)
- Gold Associate Membership – Rs. 50,000/- (Rupees fifty thousand)
- Silver Associate Membership – Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees twenty five thousand)

VI Website of AIASA: Decision was also taken to resolve the technical problems of the website of association (www.aiasa.co.in) after having a meeting with the representatives of AIASA with its web engineer. It was decided to give not more than Rs. 50,000/- (Rupees fifty thousand) to the web engineer in addition to the kind monetary support of Rs. 25,000/- (Rs twenty five thousand) rendered to AIASA by Technical Officers Association of Ministry of Agriculture (Government of India) in the form of cheque of Rs. twenty five thousand to the web engineer. The General body appreciated the support provided by Technical Officers Association, Ministry of Agriculture and in lieu of kind support provided by TOA, the AIASA has decided to accord Silver Associate Membership to TOA, Ministry of Agriculture. The registration renewal charges of the website app. Rs.5000/- will also be paid by society.

VI. Appointment of Local coordinators: It was also decided that the University Coordinators can nominate a few numbers of students as local coordinators at different colleges/sub campuses to have more accessibility to the members. Facilitators/Local Coordinators will be



duly appreciated but they will not be the part of National executive committee/governing Body of AIASA because of limitation of maximum number of executives upto 75.

VII. It was decided that the state West Bengal will come in the East Zone of AIASA.

The Notification for appointment will be issued separately.

The meeting ended with the vote of thanks to the chair and to our Honorary Policy Advisor Dr. Sahadeva Singh.
