It has been decided by this Association to organize National Outreach Programme AAWAHAN 2020 from 15th July- 15th October, 2020 throughout the country including in all the campuses of Central Agricultural Universities, State Agricultural Universities, Central Universities, Deemed Universities and other Universities/Institutions having agricultural faculties through its 700 Cabinet members. The Governing Board of All India Agricultural Students Association annually confers the AAWAHAN Awards to the persons based on their outstanding contributions for empowerment of youth in Agriculture during National Outreach Programme. For the year 2020, the AAWAHAN awards will be conferred on the occasion of 6th National Youth Convention, 2021. The guidelines of AAWAHAN Awards 2020 is given as under:

AAWAHAN Awards 2020-Guidelines

- 1. AIASA AAWAHAN awards are exclusively kept for the AIASA members for their outstanding contribution for empowerment of youth during National Outreach Programme.
- 2. The outreach programme includes awareness programme about welfare activities, online (www.aiasa.org.in)/offline membership drive, meetings, workshops or awareness through social sites- Whatsapp, Facebook, Instagram, Twitter etc., and other activities undertaken for welfare of agricultural youth.
- 3. Based on the applications received, the verification will be done at appropriate level by the Committee at AIASA HQ.
- 4. Activities for AAWAHAN awards will be considered during the period of 15th July-15th October 2020.
- 5. A minimum membership added by the applicant for AAWAHAN award should be 300.
- 6. The prescribed application form/nomination form must be submitted through Head of Institution/Dean/DSW.
- 7. The nomination for the AAWAHAN Award is required to be submitted from 20th October-10th November to National President, AIASA at his email national president@aiasa.org.in.

Hon'ble Vice Chancellors are requested to kindly facilitate for organizing the aforesaid programme through AIASA Units in respective campuses. Wherever units are not established, the programme can be organized through DSW for having strong linkages with students for betterment of

this sector. It is also requested that all the students and faculties may kindly be encouraged to join online membership of this organization at $\underline{www.aiasa.org.in}$.
