- 1. Candidate/Nominee must be a **member of Association on or before 31.10.2020**.
- 2. For State Cabinet: Candidate must have served for at least 1 year as a university Cabinet Member. For the constitution of State Cabinet there should be minimum 200 members required in university in a respective State. If there are more than one university in a state than minimum 500 members are required for state cabinet formation.
- 3. For University Cabinet: Candidate must have served for at least 6 months as a member of College Cabinet (College president or college secretary or college co-ordinator or extra ordinary senior member). For constitution of University Cabinet there should be minimum 100 members required in a respective University. The exemption can be granted for formation of first time AIASA Cabinet in any University or College.
- 4. For College President: Candidate must have served for at least 6 months as a college coordinator/secretary or extra ordinary member. For cabinet formation there should be minimum 50 members required in a respective College.
- 5. For College Co-ordinator/Secretary: Candidate must be a member of Association before the commencement of election.

- For NACC, NAEC and other cells including Chapters, the tenure may be renewed. However, all chapters will be treated as cells of the Association and protocol of the Association will be followed.

Important instructions:

- 1. National President, Chief Coordinator and Treasurer will be elected among the members of IARI/NCR Delhi. However, all members of the association may participate in the election by casting their votes for electing these three posts. National Treasurer & State Treasurer preferably will be elected among the lady members of the association at AIASA HQ and concerned states, respectively.
- 2. Senior Vice President post will be elected among the members of one of the zones on rotation basis. As per decision of the Association, the post of Senior Vice President will be elected among the members of South Zone based on the suitability of candidates. Those who are having 2 years experiences in the activities of the Association including one year as State or Central Cabinet member will be considered (Rigorous screening will be carried out by sub-committee and Returning Officer). The candidate (s) having less than one year academic year period will not be consider.
- 3. General Secretary will be elected among the members of West Zone. Those who are having 2-3 years experiences in the activities of the Association including one year as State or Central Cabinet member will

be considered (Rigorous screening will be carried out by sub-committee and Returning Officer). The candidate (s) having less than one year academic year period will not be consider.

- 4. Six Vice Presidents of the association will be elected in all six zones -one in each zone considering major field of specialization such as Agriculture, Horticulture, veterinary Science, Fisheries, Home Science, Agriculture Engineering, ABM etc. Person having minimum one year experience as Cabinet member of AIASA either in the Central Cabinet or State Cabinet will be considered. The candidate (s) having less than one year academic year period will not be consider.
- 5. Six Joint Secretaries of the association will be elected in all 6 zones- one in each zone considering major field of specialization such as Agriculture, Horticulture, veterinary Science, fisheries, Home Science, Agriculture engineering, ABM etc. Person having minimum one year experience as Cabinet member of AIASA either in the Central Cabinet or State Cabinet will be considered. The candidate (s) having less than one year academic year period will not be consider.
- 6. The post of Vice President and Joint Secretary both in each zone will not allotted normally in the Same University. Both the posts will be rotated among the states within the zones.
- 7. State President, State Secretary, State Treasurer, State PRO will be appointed by Association on the recommendation of Core Committee based on the nominations and suitability of candidates.
- 8. University Coordinator-cum President will be elected among the members of each Agricultural University/CAU/Central University/Deemed University/Independent Institutions/ Private University (having agriculture and allied faculty) as per para(2) of rules and regulations. Efforts should be made by electing these office bearers on consensus basis by calling General body of the members by existing University President through DSW /Dean of concerned University) s). If need arises, the election will be held by secret ballot by appointing local returning officer or online election. Person having at least one year experience as Cabinet member of AIASA in any position will be considered. The nomination recommended by University Authorities for the person having high academic calibre and social index will also be considered as fresh candidate for this post. Final year candidate in any course having less than 6 month time will not be consider for the University listed in the scroll at AIASA website if the registered members of that University as on 31.10.2020 having 100 or more members. For State President the membership strength should not be less than 200 in case of one University and 500 if more than 2 Universities are listed and active in the scroll.
- 9. College Coordinator-cum President & College Secretary will be elected among the members of concerned college(s) by calling General body of the College. The existing University Coordinator will call the General Body meeting under the guidance of DSW. The College coordinators may be also nominated/elected if strength of the College is more than 500 nos of students in a college.
- 10. The tenure of existing members of NAEC and NACC may be renewed or fresh members may be nominated. Executive Members/ Members of National Anti Corruption Cell, National Editorial Board will be replaced based on the recommendation of Chairman of the concerned body. The State Education Cell, State Anti Corruption Cell members will be nominated by members in the concerned State or centre based on the social aptitude, educational background, public reputation etc. The suitability of the candidates may be decided by Election Sub Committee and Returning Officer at AIASA HQ. The other committees such as International Cooperation Cell, Incubation Cell, National Women Empowerment Cell etc will be constituted by the Association on the recommendation of Core Committee.
